

Discipleship: Following The Way Of The Lord Jesus

Our world today is in a sad state. Many people can't see anything positive in life. They've given up the faith they received. These people need something. They need Someone. They need Jesus. People need to know that there is truth, and beauty and meaning in life. People need to know that Jesus is present for them also, not as a ghost, but as the real Risen Lord wanting to share His Life with them. That is why the message of the Lord is called the Gospel. The word *Gospel* means *Good News!*

How can people come to know this Good News? Through <u>us</u>. In today's gospel, the Risen Christ challenges his disciples – and us – to recall what he taught and what they had witnessed in his time among them. The reading concludes with Jesus telling the disciples, and us, *You are witnesses*.

During court proceedings, witnesses are more than onlookers or spectators. They are active participants who help determine the outcome. The same is true of our witness for Christ. We are to be active participants in a matter of absolute importance—the truth of Jesus' wonders and love and reality. Our voices can be heard in our workplace, our neighborhood and among our family and friends. Jesus calls us to be active witnesses, telling them about the reality of Jesus in our lives.

You and I have been given a mission by Jesus. The gospel is too good not to share! People need to know the Good News about the Lord. All need to touch him and see that life is beautiful when lived with the Lord.

Are you willing to bring Jesus to them? In what creative ways might we witness today?
