

Discipleship: Following The Way Of The Lord Jesus

Today is Good Shepherd Sunday.

Jesus said that He is the Good Shepherd who knows and loves us.

While mention of shepherds and sheep may make us think of warm coats, very few of us really appreciate the depths of intimacy found in the declaration, *I am the good shepherd*.

When Jesus calls himself *The good shepherd*, he is using an example that would have been very familiar to his listeners. The sheep had to be fed and watered and protected. Shepherds had to keep an eye out for predators, while herding the sheep away from dangerous areas.

Outdoors in all conditions for long periods of time, shepherds literally had to surrender a large part of their lives for the sheep in their care.

Because of this great commitment of the shepherd to the sheep, Jesus uses this same image to speak of his own dedicated love. Jesus is our Good Shepherd, who knows and cares for us. Jesus likened this relationship between shepherd and sheep to the relationship He enjoys with His Father. How special we are to Him!

Yet, our shepherd was rejected; hunted down, humiliated, tortured and hung on a tree to die. He gives his life for each of the members of his flock.

The word for shepherd in Latin is *pastor*. When Jesus says He is the Good Shepherd, He is saying that He is the good Pastor. Likewise, a pastor of a Church is shepherd of the Lord's flock.

On this World Day of Prayer for Vocations, pray for your pastor, and pray that the Lord send us more priests, deacons, sisters and brothers.
