

# Discipleship: Following The Way Of The Lord Jesus

In today's gospel, Jesus' disciples are confused and frightened. Then Jesus appears and all is well, as Jesus breathes his spirit of peace into them.

Thomas, however, was not there to receive this Spirit and so he could not trust the good news about Jesus. Thomas needed to see for himself. The witness of others is important, but nothing can replace a personal encounter with the Lord.

Thomas knows exactly what to look for: the wounds in his hands and side. Because of the kind of death that Jesus suffered, we know that our God knows our pain. More than that, our God is with us in our pain and grief and suffering. That is where we can see him: in his wounds in his body today.

When we reach out our hands to help another who is hurting, we are looking for that sign. When we give parched lips a drink, or cool fevered brows, or raise up a depressed spirit, we hold his broken body with our broken body. We begin to see him and begin to feel him breathe on us the Spirit of God. So that we may be sent into the world, so that others might continue to see him in us.

This is why we come here every week. We want to see Jesus. We want to be like Thomas and see for ourselves. And, in truth, the hands we extend in love and care for others are his hands. If people cannot see Jesus here in you and in me, where else can they honestly turn?

Jesus invited Thomas to touch his wounds. He extends that same invitation to us.

Thank you to all our volunteers: our Eucharistic Ministers, Servers, Readers, Ushers, Decorators, and our Choir. Your invaluable assistance helped make our Holy Week & Easter services magnificent! May God bless you for your continued dedication to your Parish family.
