

Discipleship: Following The Way Of The Lord Jesus

More than five thousand had come to hear Jesus that day.

There must have been unemployed workers and struggling farmers there, as well as those who were embarrassed to be there. The crowd must have included exhausted moms with their babies in tow, who needed a break from their 24/7 juggling of family and household. The sick certainly had come, hoping that what they had heard about this wonderworker was true.

The happy and troubled, the doubting and the curious, the believer and the skeptic, the grateful and the broken — all found a place on the grass. Jesus welcomed every one of them.

And he fed them. He fed them all.

The early Christians loved to tell this Gospel story over and over again. The scene mirrors the gathering at our table today. A crowd of all ages and backgrounds come to see Jesus. Both saints and sinners, all are welcomed.

At the heart of the story, is the little boy who brought his meager gifts to Jesus. While the disciples stood around saying they haven't enough, the boy said: *This is what I have. Take it!* Use it! And the Lord worked a mighty miracle!

God wants to do the same with us. God wants us to bring our meager gifts for Jesus to work a miracle again.

If Jesus can feed the crowds with the loaves and the fish, if Jesus can change bread and wine into Himself, just think what He can do with us, if we bring ourselves and what we have to Him!

Surrender to Jesus Christ, and be amazed at what mighty miracles God can do with you!






