WEDDINGS: Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

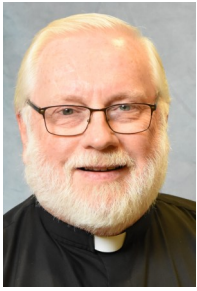
BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

From the Pastor

The Beatitudes in Luke's Gospel immediately follow the call of the twelve apostles. For these disciples, following Jesus meant being disowned by their own families, loss of their livelihoods, hatred from their friends and much grief.

It is to these that Jesus says: *Blessed are you who are poor, for the kingdom of God is yours. Blessed are you who are now hungry, for you will be satisfied. Blessed are you who are now weeping, for you will laugh. Blessed are you when people hate you..., your reward will be great in heaven.*

Jesus' words in today's gospel are his encouragement to people who wonder what they have let themselves in for, who wonder if the cost of following Jesus Christ might be too high.

To these Jesus says we will be happier if we are poor, hungry, crying, and disliked by others.

When we are poor, we trust in God to supply everything we need, instead of depending on our wealth. When we are hungry for God, we know that God will satisfy our hunger. When we are weeping, we can rely on God to comfort us and ease our pain. And when we think we have no friends, still we have a friend in Jesus, who never leaves us.

In today's Gospel, Jesus challenges us to measure our life's worth, not in terms of wealth or power or fame, but in our embracing a new vision, a new attitude about life that honors humility and compassion, that frees us from the pursuit of the things of this world, in order to seek the lasting things of God.

When we do this, our Lord tells us: *Blessed are you....*

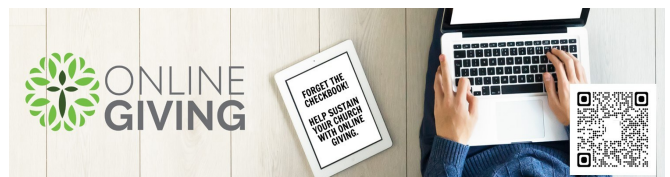
