WEDDINGS: Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

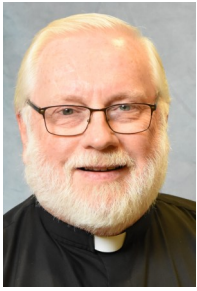
BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

From the Pastor

Jesus' first public act is to invite others to share his ministry.

Jesus asks a hesitant Simon to help him in preaching to the crowd by rowing his boat out from shore. His call comes to an ordinary man, who is in the midst of his own struggle to make a living for himself and his family. Simon agrees and so Simon uses his everyday occupation to help spread the gospel, and is rewarded with a miraculous catch of fish.

Jesus is saying he does not want to carry out his ministry alone. Jesus wants people side by side with him in the task. He calls on ordinary people, aware of their own powerlessness and sin, to join him in proclaiming good news to the poor, freedom to those in bondage, and new sight to the blind.

Jesus invites weak, imperfect people like you and me to join him in being *fishers of men*, working miracles of love and healing in our world today. He uses the ordinary circumstances of our daily lives and work situations to *catch people* for the kingdom of God.

Indeed, God still calls us today. Jesus asked Simon Peter to trust him, to trust him so much that Peter would be willing to leave the shallow places in his life to begin to explore the depths, to go to the limits of what he thinks is possible, not only for him but for those all around him.

Go out into the deep water, says Jesus, trust me and see what happens.

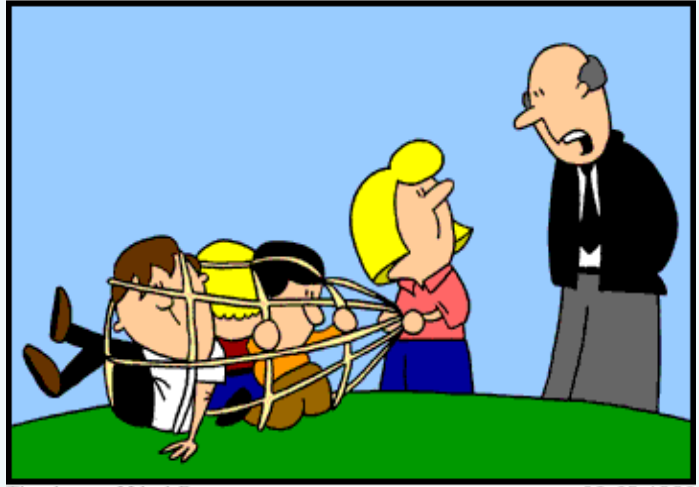

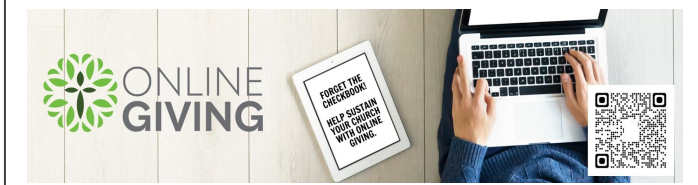

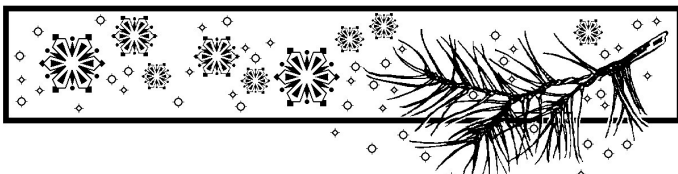
