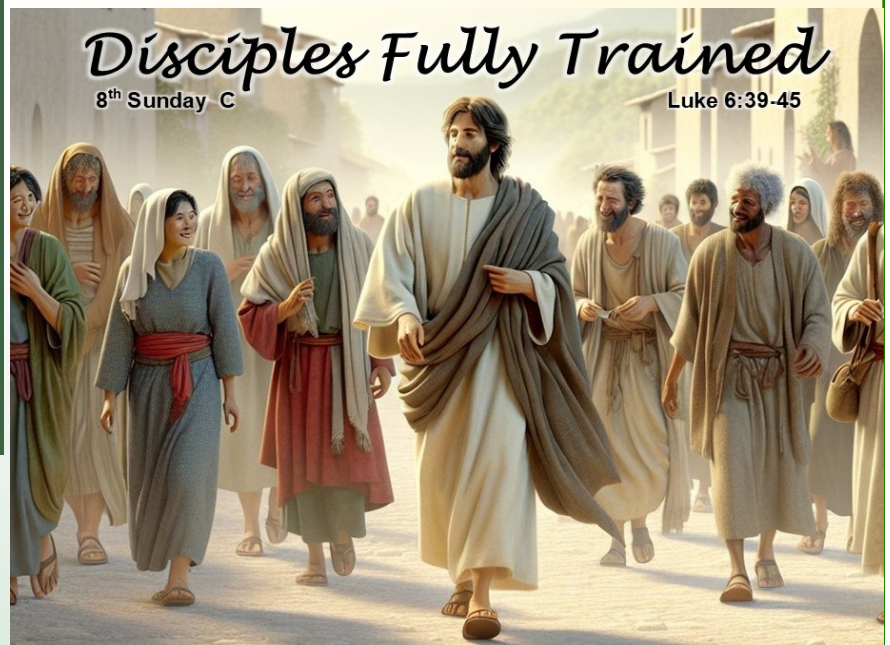

WEDDINGS: Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

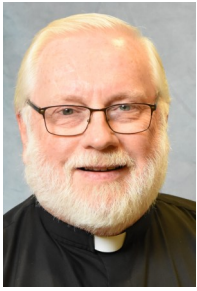
BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

From the Pastor

I want to change. I want to be like Jesus. Jesus speaks to us about us being like Him in today's gospel.

Jesus says that although a disciple *is not superior to the teacher*, still a disciple *will be like his teacher... when fully trained*.

He challenges us to be disciples fully trained – to be like Jesus!

He gives us two parables about seeing clearly: The first parable says *the blind cannot lead the blind*. We are *blind* when we follow illusions of pride and control, or make judgments of others that make us feel superior. Consider the illusion of self-sufficiency, which *blinds* us to the reality of our need for others, and their need for us. Or think of the illusion of low self-esteem, in which we so focus on our own shortcomings that we become paralyzed, thinking ourselves unable to act. The reality is that we can all contribute something unique and precious in God's Plan, even if it is only a gentle touch, or a generous smile.

The second parable speaks of wooden beams blocking our eyes, where the temptation to point out the shortcomings of others blinds us from seeing, and addressing, our own faults. To be like Jesus, we must see clearly. Jesus chose a path of loving service, which led him to suffering and death, but also to joy and life. Jesus calls us to that same conversion of heart, so we may flourish with abundant life.

We want to change. We want to be like Jesus. Do this, practice this, live this, and we will be like Jesus.
