WEDDINGS: Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

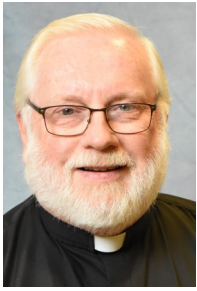
BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

From the Pastor

In the Gospel, Jesus is tempted, not so much to do evil, as to choose some lesser good. The first temptation is to bread, to filling ourselves with material goods. It's so easy for us to give in to a culture that says we should have more and more. Jesus shows us the way: to trust in God, rather than having more than what is needed.

The second temptation is to power, to dominate, to make things happen the way we want and to force people to do what we want. Jesus invites us to reject power, to examine our interactions with people so that our relationships are based on trust and integrity.

The third temptation, is to manipulate God, for Jesus to take a short-cut: to win the world without enduring the cross. Of course, Jesus rejected that too.

As the Lord's disciples today, we follow the example of Jesus. That's why we celebrate Lent.

In Lent, we strive to recover from the negligence of the rest of the year and make a deeper commitment to the Lord through prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

Giving is at the heart of who God is. Giving is at the heart of who we are. Just as the fruit a tree produces is a sure sign of life, so are the gifts that we give a clear sign that we are spiritually alive and that the Lord's abundant, generous giving fills our lives. To do otherwise is a barrier to a strong relationship with Jesus.

Lent is a time of preparation for Holy Easter, to take seriously the call to repent and transform ourselves, to make the old new and the darkness light: this is what Lent is all about.

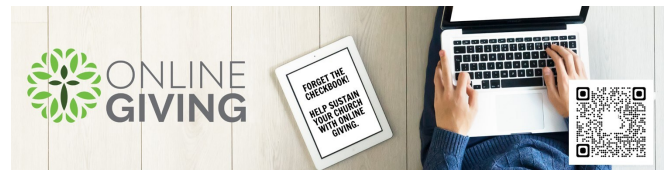

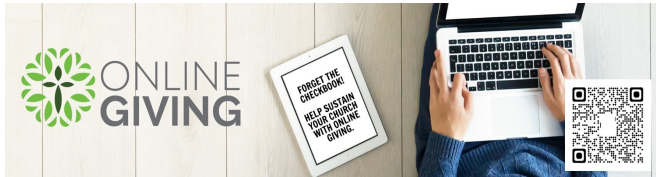

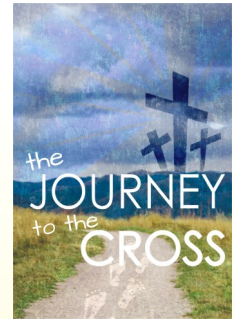

March 9, 2025 – First Sunday Of Lent

THE BENEDICTINE CROSS RESTORATION PROJECT

Starting in the fall of 2021 a small group of volunteers started cleaning the cast iron Benedictine crosses in the Saint Vincent Cemetery. Following that cleaning, Dr. Michael Krom's Saint Vincent College students sprayed Rustoleum over those crosses. Next volunteers applied an industrial primer and then a high gloss enamel paint to each of the crosses.



That process continued through the summers for the next 3 years, and as of last fall 700 crosses have been painted! The new coats of paint should last for the next two decades!

Looking forward to the warm days of spring, we will be replacing the sealant between the bottom of the crosses and their cement bases. This process is labor intensive but easy to do.
