WEDDINGS: Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

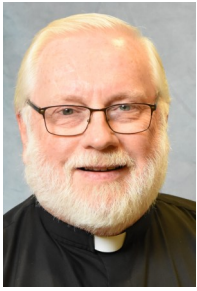
BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

From the Pastor

Jesus entered Jerusalem as a king. His royalty was not pomp and power, but humble obedience. In obedience, he set his face to Jerusalem, knowing that violence awaited him at journey's end. In obedience, he traveled along the way, eating and drinking with sinners, and remaining faithful to God's desire to gather the rejected and the lost. On the cross, Jesus speaks compassionately to the criminal crucified next to him: *Today you will be with me in paradise.* Then, Jesus commits himself in total trust to God. *Father, into your hands I commend my Spirit.*

To live the Christian life is to assume the pattern of Jesus' obedience, marking our own steps by his way. For Jesus, obedience meant carrying the cross, trusting that God is with him in his suffering and dying. For most of us, it means lifting a thousand little and daily crosses in the complexities and demands of our many relationships.

Too often, we give lip service to our faith on Sunday, but crucify one another on the weekday. Instead, we must be as Christ, facing evil, the violence and injustice of the world, and refusing to live in complicity with it. We are humbly to obey the God of Life, resisting all evil and death, to accompany those who suffer, especially those who suffer because of injustice, or others' insensitivity and hatred.

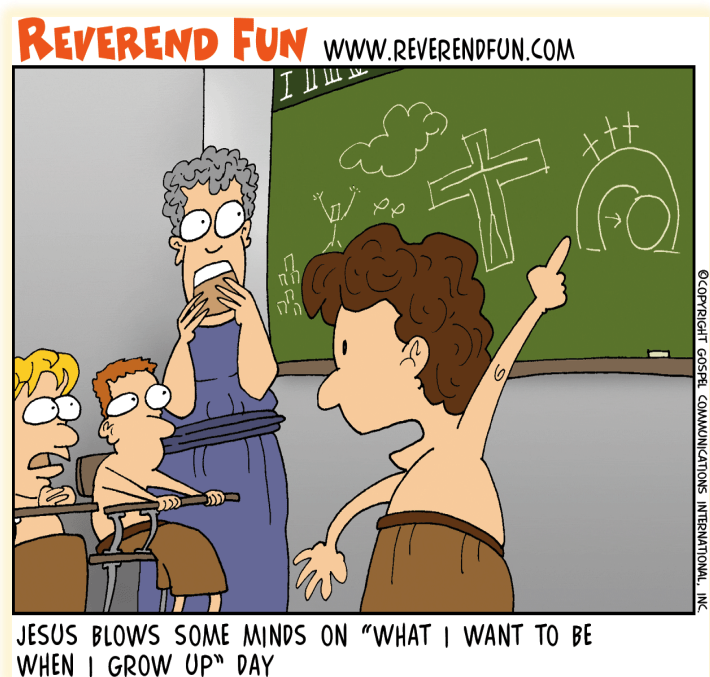
This is the week that we are called to draw near the cross, to learn its wisdom and to understand the power of forgiveness and mercy that is the sign of our salvation and freedom. We vow to live under no sign of power but the sign of the cross.

Let us go with him, all the way to glory. *Today you will be with me in paradise.*

(We cannot share fully in the joy of Easter until we remember how much God loves us by Jesus’ Passion and death on the Cross.)

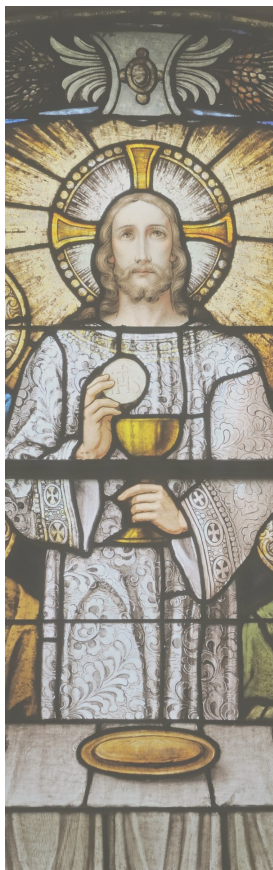
April 19: Holy Saturday - Blessing of Easter Food - 11:00am, SH; 12:00pm, SC
