**WEDDINGS:** Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

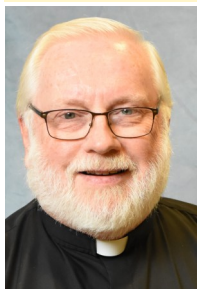
**BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.**

## From the Pastor

What most absorbs your time, your attention, and your heart?

In the parable of Lazarus and the rich man, Jesus paints a dramatic scene of contrasts — riches and poverty, heaven and hell, compassion and indifference, inclusion and exclusion. Lazarus was not only poor, but incapacitated. He was *laid* at the gates of the rich man's house.

How could anyone stand to have a poor man lying in the doorway, covered with sores, those sores being licked by stray dogs — a poor man who longs for nothing but the crumbs that fall off the table? Aren't we outraged that a rich man, dressed in purple and fine linen, who feasted sumptuously every day, ignored this poor man? We'd never do that to anyone, would we?

We also see an abrupt and dramatic reversal of fortune. We're not surprised when the rich man ends up in Hades and can't even get a tiny drink of water. What was that rich man thinking of?

In Jesus' words today, two very different lives are exposed with sobering insight. And we dare not miss their wisdom. A life well lived is never lived apart from those around us. Blessings received are never meant to be enjoyed alone. It is only in caring for those around us that we live the life God intends.

Someone once remarked that the only real reason that the Dead Sea is dead, is because it never let out any of the water that entered it. It kept it all for itself and, in failing to share, became stagnant and lifeless.

There is a lesson here for us.
