From the Pastor

Engraved on an 18th century gravestone in an old Maine cemetery is the epitaph:

We seem to give him back to Thee, dear Lord who gavest

him to us. Yet as Thou didst not lose him in giving, so too, we have not lost him by his return to You.

Those words express our faith: that our time on this earth is precious and limited. Our lives are a gift, given not only to us, but to those whose lives we touch. God makes His love present in us, and through us, to all. In death, nothing is lost, only changed and perfected. We give back to God what God has given to us with the hope that what we have made of our lives is a fitting expression of gratitude to our Maker.

On All Souls' Day, we remember the souls of our loved ones who have gone before us.

The hole in our hearts where our loved ones were, is healed by the hope of God's grace: that the dark night will cede to the morning light, that winter cold will be broken by the promised warmth of springtime, that the brokenness of our Good Fridays will be healed in the dawning of Easter.

We commend our loved ones to God in thanksgiving for their presence – for, in them, God has loved us. And we find peace in our faith in the Risen Lord, that death is not an ending, but a beginning.

May we find consolation in that they have been welcomed into the company of saints, and we pray that one day, they will welcome us.

"Faith and Family" is a gathering to help our parents grow in the faith and to learn how to help them teach their children to do the same. Grandparents are encouraged to come as well.


