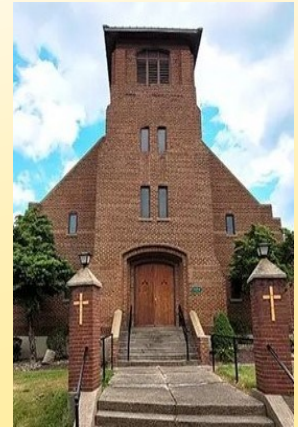

WEDDINGS: Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

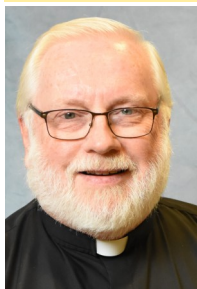
BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

From the Pastor

The Advent season begins with a vision of people at peace: *beating swords into plowshares and spears into pruning hooks.* This peace, this wholeness, does not start around a negotiation table. It starts in you and in me.

Wake Up! Jesus tells us. The Day of the Lord is upon us! The battle for the Lord is not something that will take place many years from now. It is a battle that we are engaged in, here and now.

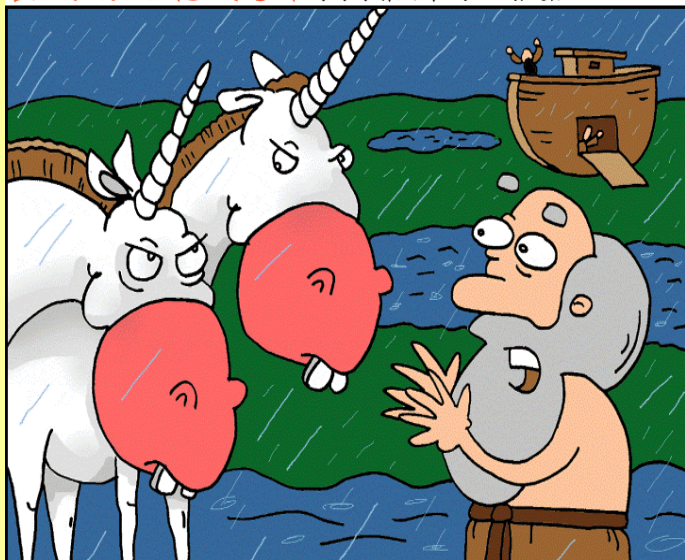

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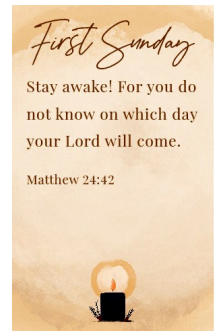
