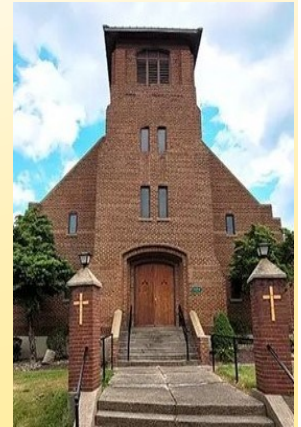

WEDDINGS: Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

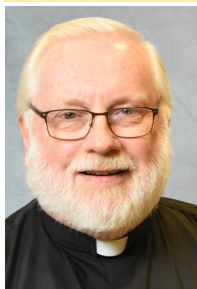
BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

From the Pastor

Today we celebrate the dedication of the Basilica of St. John Lateran, the first purpose-built Christian Church. Beginning in 313 AD, when Christian communities were free to construct public buildings, the Church on the Lateran Hill became the pope's cathedral as Bishop of Rome and the model for all the great cathedrals which would be built in Europe, and thus the *mother church* of the Christian world.

Today's solemnity celebrates of the unity of all our churches: from the Pope's Cathedral in Rome, to our own here in Whitney and Youngstown.

Because we are sinners, we may, at times, hurt one another. Jesus warns us again and again not to criticize, compare or judge one another. St. Paul warned about *cannibal* Christians who, by their words, *devour one another* and destroy the Church (Galatians 5:15). Instead, we must passionately love the Church in spite of its imperfections and personalities, and should focus on loving one another and fulfilling God's purposes for us.

If you are part of God's family, you should have that same zeal for the Church that Jesus had. You are commissioned by God to pray for your Church and its unity. It is the responsibility of all of us, to protect that unity and to promote harmony in our Church family and among all believers.

What are you doing personally to make our Church more inviting and welcoming, more active in love and service, more holy and Christ-like?

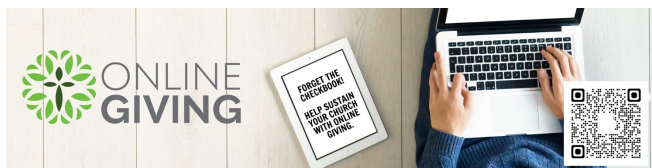

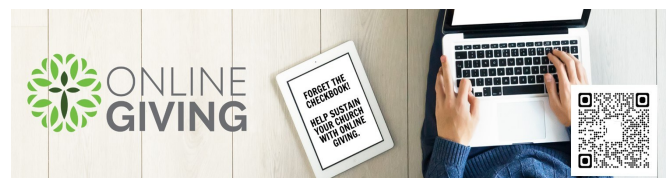

What if it is all true.. What is the game changer?

We will begin to explore the extraordinary teachings of our **Catholic faith**; not just a part of our lives, but the very foundation of everything.

The desire for God is written in the human heart, because man is created by God and for God; and God never ceases to draw man to himself. Only in God will he find the truth and happiness he never stops searching for." (CCC 27)

OCIA - a journey of faith.

"Interested in the Catholic Faith?"

~Do you have a child over the age of seven who has not been baptized?

~Was baptized Catholic as a child, but has not received the Sacraments of Confirmation and the Eucharist?

OCIA is an invitation to change and grow as the human being that God is calling you to be.

All of us are on a spiritual journey—a journey of faith—with the same destination but traveled at different speeds. This process, which we today call the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults/Children (OCIA), follows the mission commanded by Jesus Christ: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit." *Matthew 28*

What is OCIA?

The **Order of Christian Initiation of Adults** is the way people are initiated into the Christian way of life, specifically in the Roman Catholic tradition. It is a journey of discovery, where participants come to know Jesus Christ.

So, what do we do on this journey?

We learn what prayer is, and why and how to pray. We learn about the Kerygma = the proclamation of the Gospel, and how our relationship with God will grow through the Sacred Scriptures. As our relationship develops with God on this journey, we will discover Jesus' Mission for the Church and also within our parishes and our community.

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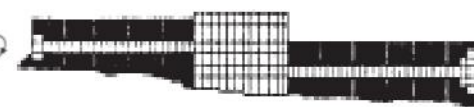
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
