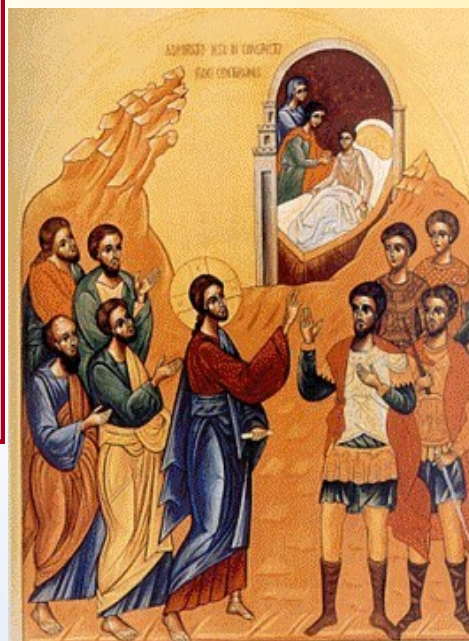

**WEDDINGS:** Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

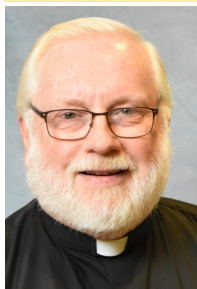
**BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.**

## From the Pastor

Thomas was not the only one to have had his doubts. The last words recorded of John is the question: *Are you the one?*

John's testimony to Jesus had been fearless and unwavering, but now, languishing in prison, he begins to wonder. Even the saints, it seems, know what it is to wrestle with uncertainty.

How does Jesus deal with John's doubts? Jesus points to miracles of love, of freedom and of healing. Jesus invites John, and us, to see what is happening as the promise and pledge of a new day.

This Advent, let us commence a new day by being our best Christian selves, by becoming beacons of light to our community. Let us spend time in prayer. Let us dedicate our Advent preparations to promoting prayer, by acts of virtue, and by sacrifice.

Let us take advantage of our Parish's Advent Penance Service this Monday evening at 7pm at St Cecilia, to further *Prepare the Way of the Lord*, unburden ourselves of our sin, and experience the joy of being reconciled with God and with one another.

Like John's disciples, we have seen and heard the Lord in our own lives. Now, we must make the trip back to others who haven't, or whose lives are so desperate that, on their own, they cannot see any deeds, or hear any words, that offer them hope.

Let us be less judgmental and more understanding, less demanding and more forgiving—which might go a long way to enable *the blind to regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers cleansed, the deaf hear and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them.*

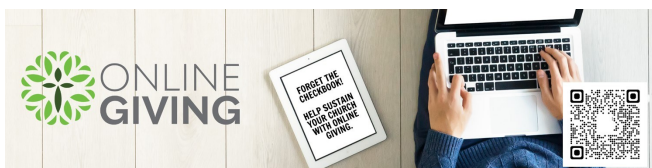

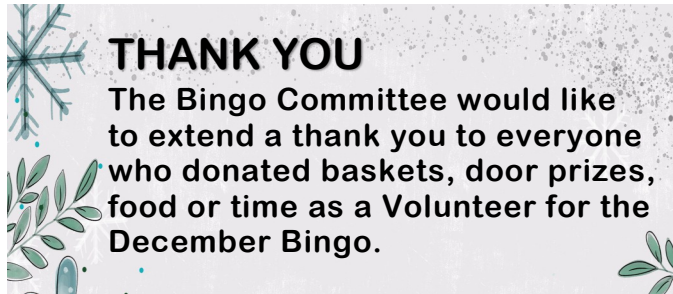

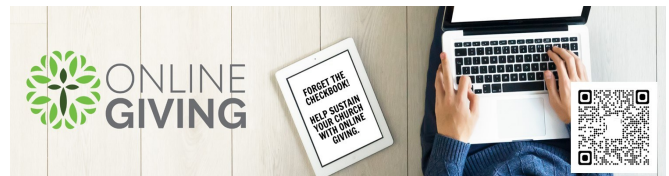
