WEDDINGS: Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

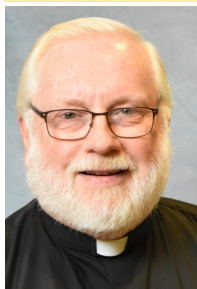
BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

From the Pastor

John the Baptist's preaching begins with the proclamation of salvation: *The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand*, a Kingdom of justice and peace, of lions lying down with lambs, envisioned by Isaiah the prophet. There is nothing more solid and sure than this message. It is our asking the question: *Am I loved?* And John says, *God's answer is: YES!*

But, John's is also a voice of Thundering Judgment. For if we're going to be really honest, deep down, we know we are broken and our world is broken. We are both wheat and chaff, and the chaff must be burned away. We must take a scalpel to cut out whatever in us does not bear good fruit.

A broken world needs a place to bring its spiritual injuries. We need an emergency room to heal what is broken inside, to get down to the root causes of our problems and have our wounds tended. This is the WHY of Church: The Church is a hospital for sinners, and all of us in the Church need to do our part to heal wounds – to be healing, as we are being healed.

This Advent get rid of everything that's blocking the way of the Lord in you. Give more love and be less selfish. Remember the poor and give thanks for all your blessings. Give more time to prayer and less to talk about others. Remember that Jesus came to save you and to offer you salvation and eternal life, and it is God's free gift.

God is still speaking to us today, for God has not forgotten us or abandoned us. Rather, God is calling us to return home to the God who loves us.

To the Sacred Heart Catholic Church and The Diocese of Greensburg,

I am writing this to express our extreme gratitude to Sacred Heart Church and the Diocese of Greensburg for allowing the Unity Township Bureau of Fire and our partners access to train at the Sacred Heart School site.

I cannot stress enough the importance of training scenarios within standing structures, it is as close as we can safely get to real world evolutions and these opportunities are difficult to come by.

Just to put into perspective what we were able to accomplish because of your generosity, we spent approximately 75-100 hrs. on site, we trained approximately 80 firefighters from 10 different Departments in more than 10 primary skill sets that ranged from Self Contained Breathing apparatus search and rescue to forcible entry and self rescue.

As you can see we took full advantage of the opportunity your organizations afforded us!

In closing I would like to express our gratitude to you for your continued support of the emergency services in our area, it truly is a collaborative effort!!

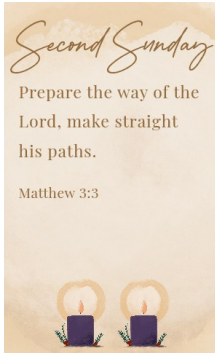
