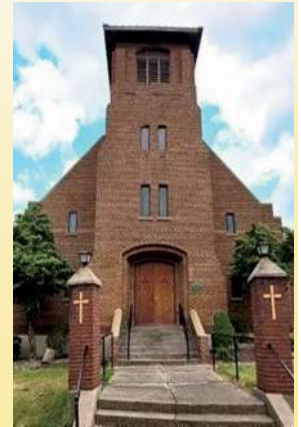

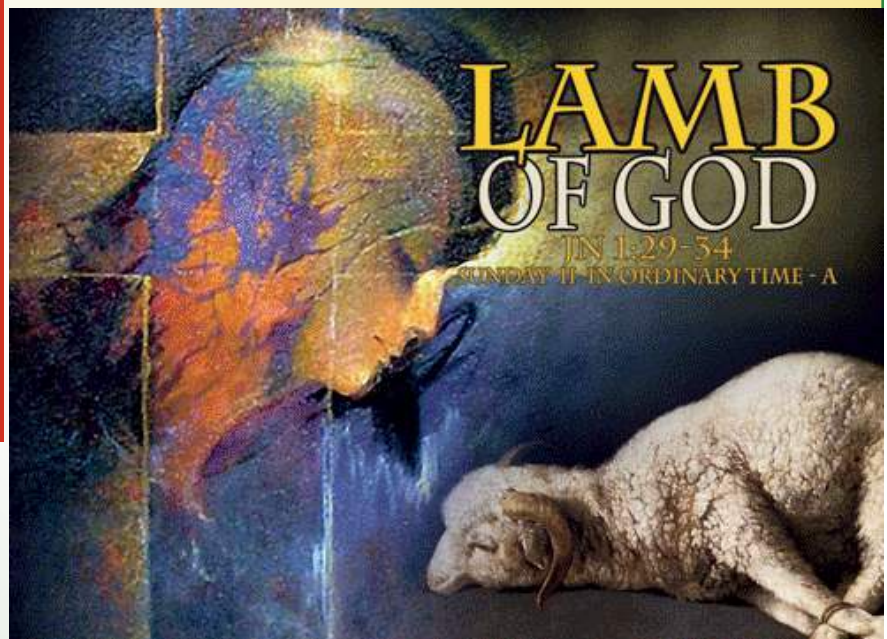

From the Pastor

Today, John the Baptizer testifies to his disciples about Jesus: *Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!*

Jesus is the *Lamb of God* because, like a lamb, He sacrificed himself completely for others. He came to live as the Father wants us all to live: so that we could experience sacrificial love.

When we say or sing, *Lamb of God* at Mass, we are remembering what Jesus did for us and what he has empowered us to do for others. We are remembering his sacrifice to make God's love real on earth. We are reminding ourselves that joining Jesus in sacrificial love is the only way we can be His followers.

John the Baptist found his reason for existence. He was to point out the *Lamb of God* to the world. Because John loved to show and tell others about Jesus, many people came to know Jesus and follow Him.

His mission is not different from the mission of every Christian. It is important for you and me to show and tell others about Jesus too. We are to point out the *Lamb of God* to the world.

We can show others about Jesus by doing the things that Jesus taught us to do, by loving one another and being helpful and kind. Every time we show self-sacrificing love to others, we show and tell others about Jesus.

Throughout this New Year, may we continue to *Behold the Lamb of God*, and show and tell others about this great love of Jesus, just like John did that day.

WORD OF LIFE – January 2026

The 2026 March for Life is set for Friday, January 23, at 1:00 p.m. on the National Mall in Washington, D.C.

The National Prayer Vigil for Life will begin Thursday, January 22, with the opening Mass at 5 p.m. in the Great Upper Church of the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington. At 7 p.m., a national Holy Hour for Life will take place in the Crypt Church of the Basilica, including recitation of the Rosary and Benediction. The closing Mass will be at 8 a.m. Friday, Jan. 23 in the Great Upper Church. The Masses will be televised on **EWTN and livestreamed at www.nationalshrine.org/mass.**

Bishop Larry J. Kulick will concelebrate the opening Mass and will also celebrate **Mass at 10:30 a.m. Friday in the basilica’s Immaculate Heart of Mary Chapel.** All pilgrims from the Diocese of Greensburg are invited to join him. During the march itself Bishop Kulick will be greeting participants at the corner of Constitution Avenue Northwest and 12th Street Northwest as they rally towards the Supreme Court building.

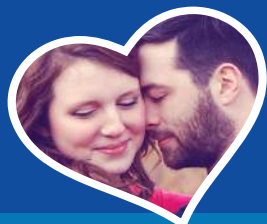
