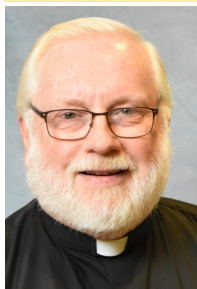

From the Pastor

A little puppy noticed that whenever he was happy, his tail wagged, so he thought he had found the secret to happiness.

One day he shared the secret of happiness with an older dog. He said, *I have learned that the best thing for a dog is happiness, and that happiness is in my tail. So I am going to chase my tail; and when I catch it, I shall have happiness!*

The old dog replied, *I too, believe that happiness is a marvelous thing for a dog, and that happiness is in my tail. But I have noticed that when I chase it, my tail keeps running away from me; but when I go about my business, it follows me wherever I go.*

The Bible has a lot to say about being happy. It doesn't say, *Happy are they who have a lot of money or Happy are they who live in big houses and drive fancy cars.* It doesn't even say, *Happy are they who only have good things happen to them.*

What the Bible does say is, *Happy are the merciful, happy are the peacemakers, and happy are the pure in heart.* The Bible also says, *Happy is he who trusts in the Lord.*

Many of us are like that little puppy chasing his tail -- trying to find true happiness that is always just out of our reach. What we need to do is learn that if we will just go about our business and trust in the Lord, and happiness will follow us wherever we go.

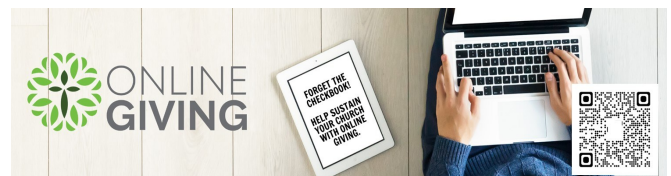


