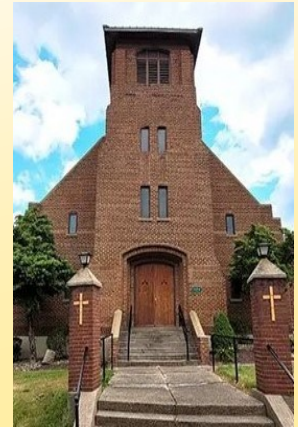

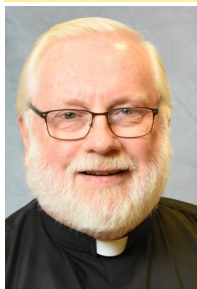

## From the Pastor

The Christmas season officially comes to an end today. The glad tidings and good cheer of the holiday season have been packed away for the next 11 months as we gather at the banks of the Jordan River for the baptism of Jesus by John.

When Jesus submitted humbly to John's baptism, the heavens opened and the Spirit of God came upon him. As with Gabriel's announcing to Mary that she would give birth to a son who will be born of the Holy Spirit, descends like a dove and rests upon him. Then Jesus hears the voice of God calling him *beloved*. In other words, the Spirit of God resided within Jesus, that God's peace, compassion and love was a constant presence within the Carpenter of Nazareth.

That day Jesus stepped into the River Jordan and was washed by John, he was beginning his public life, his mission. His baptism was his initiation, his entrance into that mission. He emerged from the water dripping with God's Spirit and commissioned by the Father to do His work.

Today, the same Spirit that anoints the Christ for his mission -- and which WE are baptized with in our own baptism -- calls us to be about the work of Christ in this new year: to seek out and find the lost, to heal the hurting, to feed the hungry, to free the imprisoned, to rebuild families and nations, to bring the peace of God to all peoples everywhere.

Ask the Holy Spirit to renew your relationship with God, to know you are His beloved, and to be about His work.

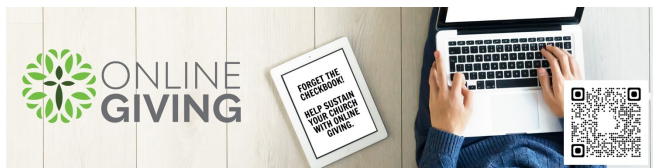

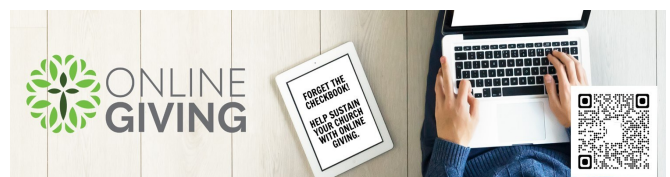

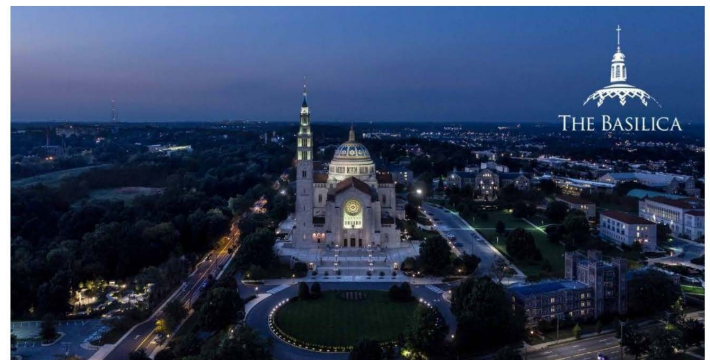
