



From the Pastor

After the arrest of John the Baptist, Jesus takes up where John left off. He begins to proclaim John's message: *Reform your lives! The kingdom of God is at hand.* Jesus then begins to invite disciples to *Come follow me!* Instead of targeting the best and brightest, Jesus calls ordinary fishermen, knee-deep in the family business. Simon and Andrew, James and John immediately leave their former way of life and follow Jesus.

They were not the sort of people anyone would expect to convince others to change their lives, or who could be leaders in the conversion of the world. In fact, they so often missed the point that Jesus was trying to make, that I'm sure there must have been times that Mary just rolled her eyes when she heard about the antics of these characters. Yet they heard the call of the Lord, dropped everything and followed him.

What is absolutely amazing, is that God is interested in reaching ordinary people – like you and me - to be part of God's plan for this world.

Today, Jesus extends the same invitation to us.

Jesus taught us that what we give away, including the gift of ourselves, grows and multiplies in the giving. This week to do a little *fishng*, to share your faith, with one person whom you know. Or, do one visible act of Christian charity to someone in need in the name of Jesus. See where it gets you.

God has a plan, and He has chosen you and me to be His ambassadors, and work wonders through us. So, follow Him and let Him make you a Fisher of People!
