

CONFESIONS: 1/2 hour before Saturday & Sunday Mass or by appt.


WEDDINGS: Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

From the Pastor

Humans are the only creatures that can claim to have been made in God's image. They were indeed like God. They could choose. They could love. And they could choose not to love.

When we choose not to love, when we choose to reject God, relegating God to a place of insignificance in our lives, we sin. Then, we are in turmoil. We have no inner harmony. We are dead to the Lord of Life, and we suffer.

Lent is a time to be renewed. We leave behind the outer baggage that can impede the journey – removing the outer shell of distractions and sin can leave us vulnerable.

We join Jesus in the desert for the forty days. We look for the causes of disharmony: How it is that we have allowed sin into our lives?

In Lent, we are challenged to repent and believe. We seek the inner union with God by revitalizing our prayer life. We choose this union over our own selfish desire. We demonstrate our union with God by making His Healing Hand present among the poor.

Repentance, prayer, fasting and almsgiving, works of charity, these are the cornerstones of Lent. They are the ways that we join Jesus in the desert as we also prepare ourselves and our world to celebrate the restored harmony with God, the new life of Easter.






