



WEDDINGS: Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.


BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

From the Pastor

Have you ever hiked to the top of a mountain? Mountains are places of mystery and majesty where we behold the good earth from a height that is a little closer to God's perspective.

One day, climbing up a mountain, the apostles began to see Jesus a new way. He caught fire from within. His clothes became dazzling white.

Just before this, Jesus spoke to them of His suffering, death and resurrection to come. Peter was not ready for this. He took Jesus aside and said: *Never, Lord! This shall never happen to you!*

But Jesus told him that he was seeing things from a purely human point of view. He needed a vision from God's point of view, that Jesus would pass through death to triumph in the end. What Peter and his fellow disciples needed was for God to open their eyes and enlighten their vision so that they could see from God's own perspective.

We are all mountain climbers; every day we scale different heights: We struggle over the mountain of self to encounter God and the things of God and come to understand that we are not the center of the universe, that the great joys and fulfillment of life lies beyond our own wants and desires and needs.

And every time we gather for the Eucharist, we experience a moment when bread and wine is changed before our eyes into our divine Lord. May the reassurance of God's loving presence with us at communion take away all fear and doubt from our hearts and strengthen us to face with courage the challenges and trials, and even death, that we must pass through before we can share in His divine glory.


"I am the light of the world." (John 9:5)


