



WEDDINGS: Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.


BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

From the Pastor

Today, Jesus cries for his dead friend Lazarus. It is a very human Jesus who does this. Death has always been the dragon who eats up our hopes and casts a shadow over our lives. But Jesus came to slay that dragon.

He does this because of his love: *Now Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus. And lest we miss the point, this means that God loves us also.*

He cries with all who are mourning the loss of a loved one.

But Jesus doesn't just weep. As a sign that life conquers death, he calls: *Lazarus come out!* Lazarus does not rise from the tomb like Jesus would rise from the dead as we will celebrate on Easter Sunday. Someone else rolls back the stone for Lazarus. He still wears the burial cloths. He did not have a glorified body as the Lord would have. Nor was his leaving the tomb permanent. Lazarus would eventually die again. Lazarus was not the point. Jesus is the point.

People die. Everyone dies. Old people die, young people die. Children die.

This isn't right. It was not meant to be. It isn't. Jesus Christ is the Lord of Life. Death does not control Him, nor does it control those who are His. Yes, physical lives still come to an end, but life continues for those who live in Jesus Christ.

As Jesus told Martha: *I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die.*

Jesus Christ has conquered death. He calls us out of the tomb of a dead world to join him in life.

Many of us have fallen out of the practice of regularly making a good confession and better rearing ourselves to meet the Lord. Maybe you have felt the desire to go to confession, but feel uncomfortable because it's been a while since your last confession. I can assure you that in the life of a priest, few things bring as much joy as being able to assure individuals of God's mercy and to pronounce those powerful words: *"The Lord has freed you from all your sins. Go in peace!"*

Kulick invites the faithful of the Diocese to participate in his final LENTEN EVENING OF REFLECTION, Adoration and Reconciliation on Wednesday, March 25, 6pm at Saint Vincent Basilica Parish. This special evening will explore the theme "Into the Heart of Christ: A Lenten Journey through John 17," with Bishop Kulick's talk focused on "That the World May Know You Sent Me: Mary's Fiat as the Model of Ecclesial Witness."

Follow Bishop Larry J. Kulick throughout Lent with his special podcast, DESERT DIARIES. If you hear the word "desert" and think of emptiness, struggles or something you'd rather avoid, you're not alone. 
