



**WEDDINGS:** Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.


**BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.**

## From the Pastor

Today we hear the very heart of the gospel: We hear how Jesus suffers and dies for us.

Our God is a God who loves us so much that God is willing to die on their behalf. We are the only religion in the world whose God gets hurt, whose God gets whipped, who gets stabbed, who has five wounds in his body, and who writhes and cries in pain on the cross.

Why? He suffers because as He said: *No greater love has a person than this, that he is willing to lay down his life for his friends.*

He dies, praying Psalm 22: *My God, my God why have you abandoned me*, which speaks of an innocent person suffering, who nevertheless maintains steadfast trust in a God who fails to rescue him.

After witnessing all this, a Centurion and the men with him, came to believe in him. These were soldiers, men hardened to cruel acts, the very ones who pressed a crown of thorns into His head and then nailed him to the cross. To them, Jesus is nothing but some bizarre character who claims to be king. Yet the more they observed him, the more they listened to him, their eyes were opened. They experienced conversion, their hearts shifted from cold, distant unbelief, to lively, certain faith. These, who just a few hours before were mocking and ridiculing Jesus, now openly declaring: Truly, this was the Son of God!

May we too experience conversion. May an earthquake take place in the life of every one of us, that we, too, may boldly proclaim that Jesus is the Son of God!




