



**WEDDINGS:** Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.


**BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.**

## From the Pastor

In our Gospel, a woman at a well is thirsty. A thirsty Jesus joins her.

Jesus speaks to her about her life, the thirst that drew her through all the detours, all the lovers of her life. He speaks to her about the longing each of us has deep within us, about putting a flowing fountain of water right inside her to refresh her spirit and renew her world.

This woman, spiritually dry and hardened by sinful habits and relationships, is transformed. She leaves her jar at the well because now she has become the vessel. She who was so full of shame that she was willing to endure the heat of the day rather than risk being seen by others, runs to tell her neighbors about her encounter with Jesus. Soon her entire village is following her back to the well to meet Jesus.

They, too, come to believe Jesus is truly the Savior of the World.

Jesus is waiting by the well of our lives too. He is ready to offer eternal life to all who will worship Him in spirit and in truth. The generous and abundant love of God is available to transform and empowers us, so that we can generously pour ourselves out for the sake of others. Whether the cup of water that we offer is a literal drink to a thirsty neighbor, or figurative cup of light and hope to someone who dwells in darkness, the ministry that we offer has the power to transform lives.

Does your life seem dry and empty? Do you thirst for Jesus? Drink deeply of His well of Living Water and then lead others to Him.




