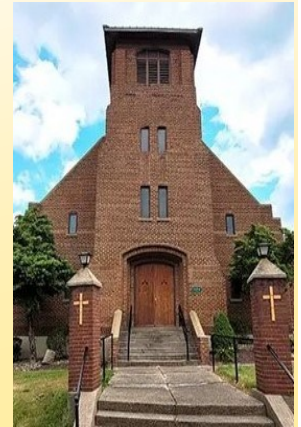

WEDDINGS: Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

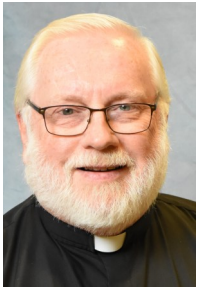
BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

From the Pastor

After the death of Jesus, two disciples make a sad journey home to Emmaus. Theirs is the road of deep disappointment, sadness, despair, and anger – a road every one of us travels, at one time or another.

On the way, they share their hopes and disappointments with a stranger. Their talking with this stranger helps them to understand the scriptures in a new way: that the Messiah had to suffer, so as to enter glory. And their hearts start to burn within them. Later, when they share a meal, their eyes, hearts and minds are opened, and, filled with joy, they recognize the Risen Lord in their midst!

Although the two disciples did not at first recognize Jesus, Jesus recognized them. Whether we always recognize Him in the various situations of our lives, or not, again and again He comes to us... in the face of someone we know, or through something that happens to us. He walks a little way with us along whatever road we're following, offering us new hope, new vision, new light.

And so it is with us. In the word we hear together and the bread we break together, we open ourselves to the presence of the Risen Lord. We share the living memory of who He is for us in the Word of scripture. We discover again and again His love for us in the sacrament of His Body and Blood.

In the blessed, broken and shared bread and wine of the Eucharist, the Risen One is never forgotten, but always present and alive, walking with us.


