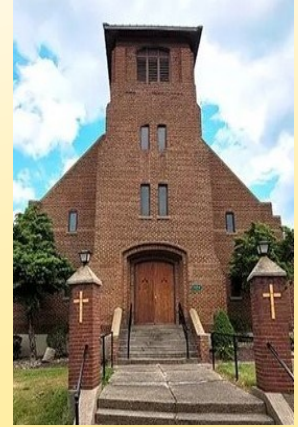

CONFESSIONS: ½ hour before Saturday & Sunday Mass or by appt.

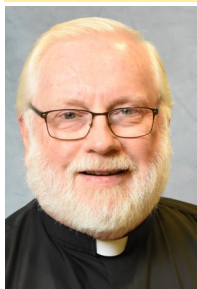
WEDDINGS: Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

From the Pastor

What God asks of us is not easy. The loss of a loved one is devastating; the pain is not quickly healed. God knows this all too well. He gave up His own Son to a terrible death.

But think about this: if you take sand, heat it until the sand melts, the result is glass! Glass can inspire us as part of a church's stained-glass windows. Glass can enlighten us as part of a light bulb. Glass can take your breath away as a beautiful Waterford crystal. But it starts as common sand, sand that has been heated in a furnace, to create something greater.

Sand and glass are a parable of Easter. At first glance, we see a man suffering the evil violence of Calvary. But look deeper. We behold a God who loves his creation enough to humble himself to become sand, and then gives it over to become the light and brilliance and beauty of glass for all eternity. We see a God who takes on our humanity and then to endure suffering and death, in order to transform despair into hope, grief into joy, death into life.

In raising his Son from the tomb, God vindicates the sacrifice of emptying one's self for the sake of another, the taking up of one's cross to bring resurrection to some Calvary, the bringing of myrrh to heal and restore the most lifeless of situations.

Easter is God's promise that love will ultimately triumph. The emptiness of loss will be filled, the darkness of grief will break - if not in this time of ours, then in the time of God to come.

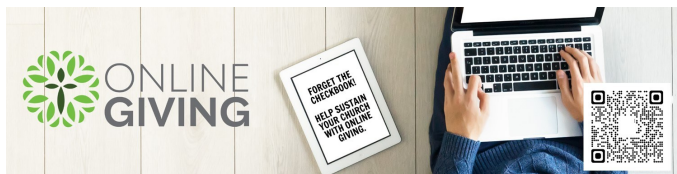

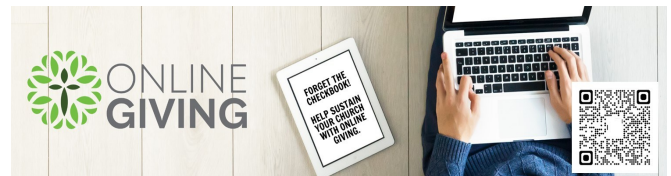


