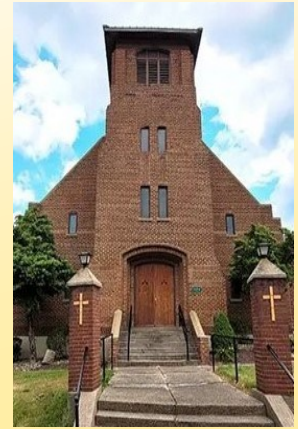

**WEDDINGS:** Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

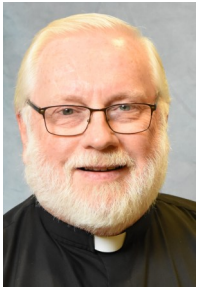
**BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.**

## From the Pastor

Jesus tells us He is our shepherd and we are His sheep.

We know His voice and follow Him. Sometimes, other voices try to get us to do something different. If Jesus is our shepherd, we won't listen to those voices.

The shepherd always wants what is best for His sheep. He leads them into green pastures where they have plenty to eat, to water where they have plenty to drink, and to shelter where they will be safe from the storm.

True Christians follow the true shepherd: they recognize His voice and they obey His commands. Some the Lord calls to family life, others to consecrated life or to the ministerial priesthood. To have this happen, someone has help them to discern their path, and to become true friends of Christ and his true disciples.

Someone has to till the soil for the seed that is to come. Someone has to intercede in prayer, to encourage in His name, and to plead for shepherds in the name of the flock. So, in His mind, our active efforts are irreplaceable.

What will you do to help Jesus shepherd His Church? Be an example to all of generous fidelity to Christ. Encourage one another to respond eagerly to the invitation of the Lord.

Jesus came so that we could have life and have it abundantly. We will, if we listen to His voice and follow Him.


