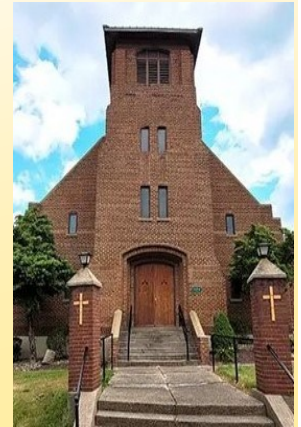

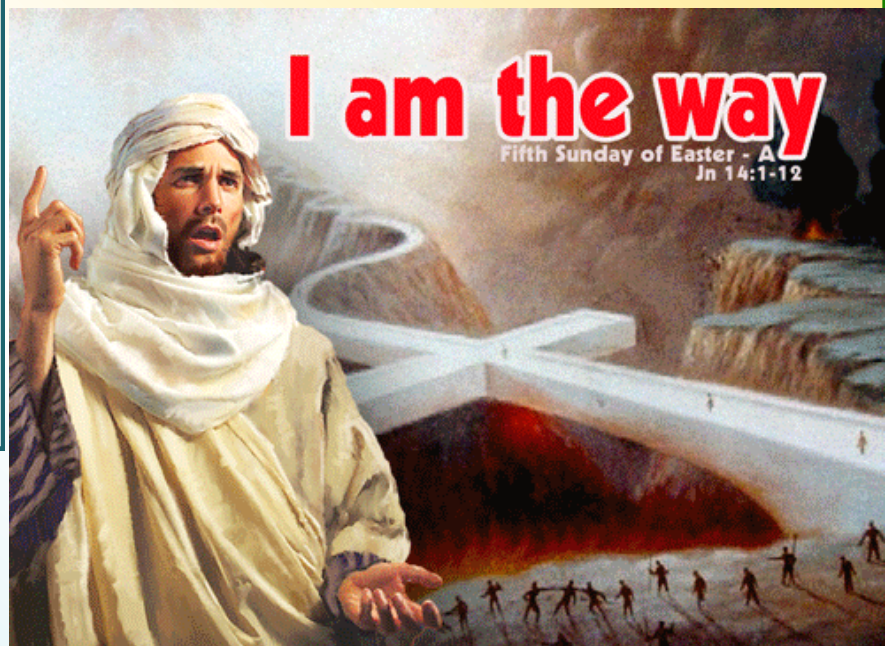

WEDDINGS: Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

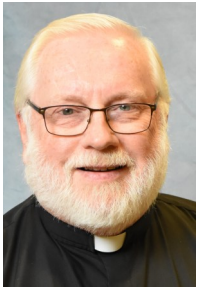
BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

From the Pastor

Jesus' description of his Father's house as having many rooms suggests the great hospitality of that house.

Heaven is not a confined space for a selected few. It is an open space for the many, just as Jesus himself did not come for the few, for the exclusive, but for all.

This is the great, good news that Jesus is the Way. He shows us this Way. To take up *the work that I do*, and to do *even greater things* than Jesus, is the work of charity, of humble service that that does not count the cost.

We can't duplicate the power of Jesus. We can't walk on water. We can't turn water into wine. But this we do have: the opportunity to express the love of Jesus. The simplest act of kindness and charity, done in God's spirit of love, is to do the very work of Christ. He has called us to be instruments of his love to people who need to experience love. And when we do those things, these acts of love are *greater* than the work that he did when he walked on water.

Even the simple tasks of being a part of our parish, is the very *work* of God. We, too, prepare a place in the Father's *house* when the poor and sick are cared for, the fallen are lifted up, and lost and rejected are sought after and brought home.

No matter who we are, or what we have done, there is a place for us all in God's kingdom of Love.

Take him as your Way, your Truth, your Life. Believe. And do *even greater things!*

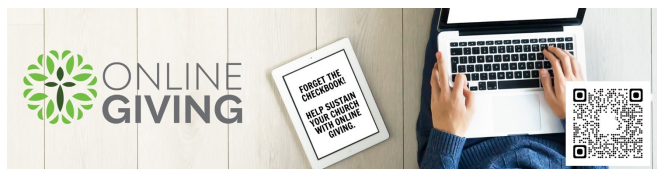


