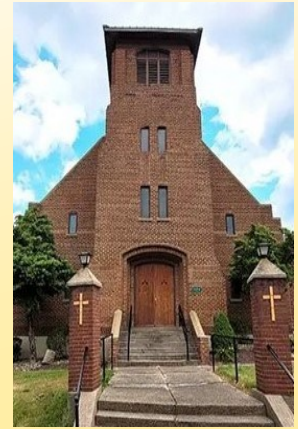

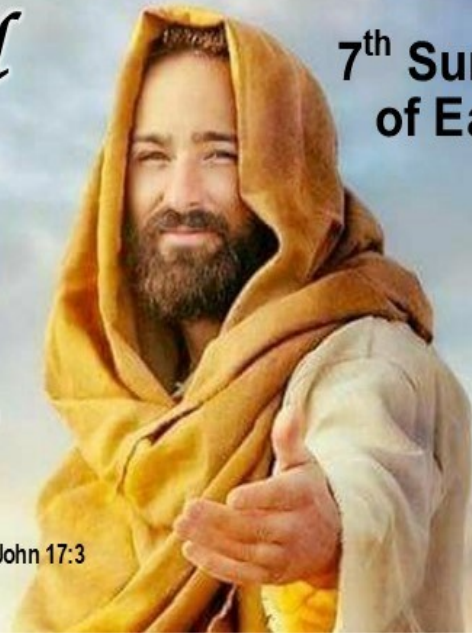

BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

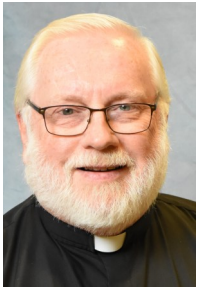
Please Note: Certificates to be a Sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation can only be given to one who is a registered and practicing member of the Parish.

From the Pastor

Today, Mary, the Mother of the Church, quietly begins her role in the Upper Room, gathered in prayer with the Apostles, waiting for the Spirit to breathe them out into the waiting world.

Today's Gospel is also a prayer, a prayer that Jesus offers on Holy Thursday night. Jesus prays that we may have eternal life: *Now this is eternal life, that they should know you, ...and the one whom you sent, Jesus Christ.*

Jesus prays that the world may come to know God through the work of His disciples to whom he has entrusted his Gospel of reconciliation and peace. He prays that we will be united, so that we may continue His work that the Father had entrusted to Him. He asks God to bless the ministry they will soon begin.

That ministry has continued through the centuries every time some parent teaches their child how to pray, every time a teacher helps a student understand a Gospel story, every time someone tells a friend how God helped him transform his life.

We are His disciples today - and Jesus entrusts to us the ministry of being Jesus to all.

During this coming week before Pentecost, enter into prayer, like Mary and the early Church in that Upper Room. Pray for a renewed outpouring of the Holy Spirit on our Church -- and on all of us -- that our Lord may draw us closer to Himself and sustain the work of our Church.

Please also pray that our celebration of Pentecost next Sunday will lead to the Church being renewed and strengthened by God's Spirit. And please believe that your prayers will be answered!

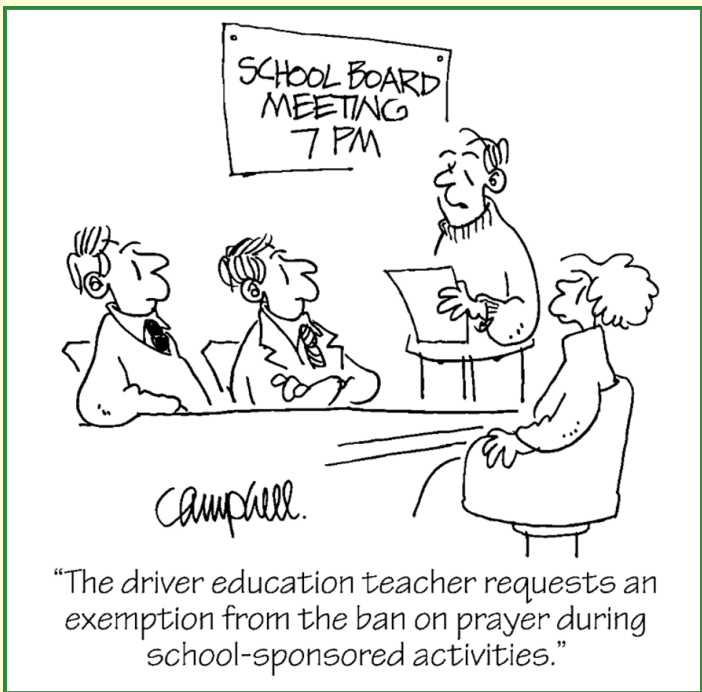


Seventh Sunday of Easter – May 17, 2026

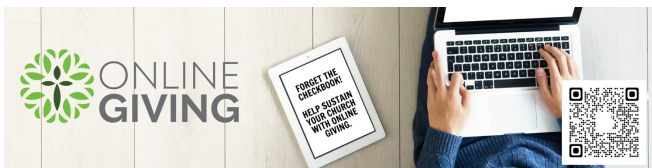

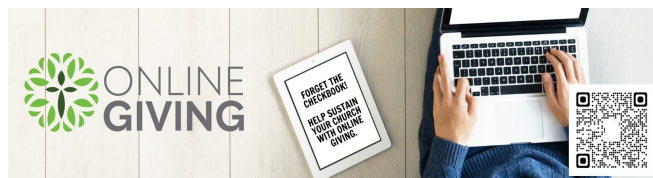


