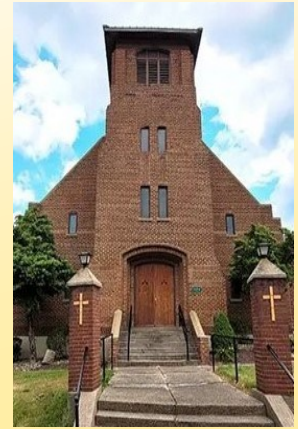

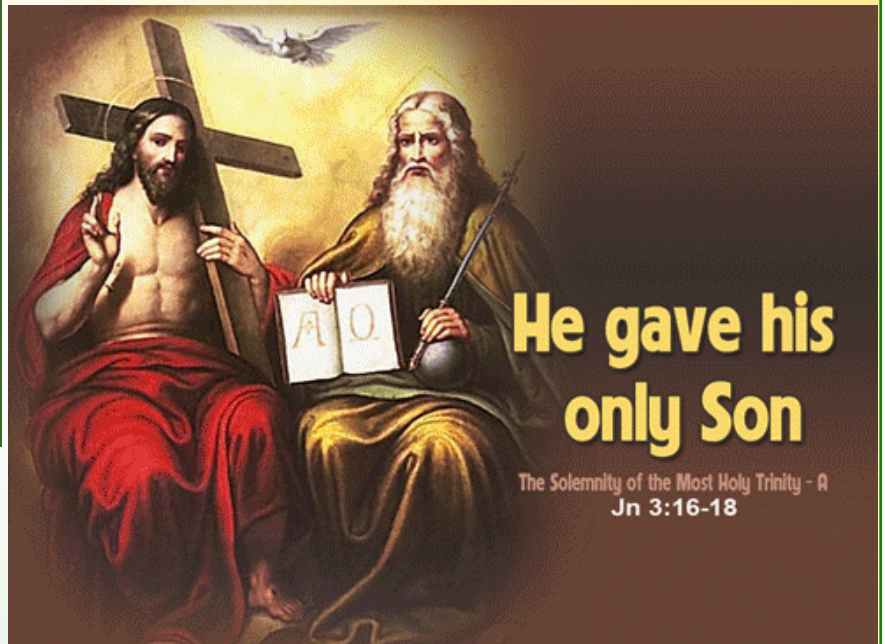

**BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.**

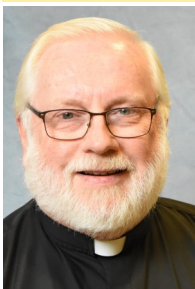
Please Note: Certificates to be a Sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation can only be given to one who is a registered and practicing member of the Parish.

## From the Pastor

God acts not for God's own sake, but for our sake. God acts not to satisfy a desire for power, or a desire to smash people into submission. God reaches out to us in love.

God sent us Jesus who died for us, to show us how much God loves us. Jesus wants to save us and take us to Heaven to be with Him.

God sent Jesus because God loves the world, both those of us who love God, as well as those who never think of God -- even those who have spurned the love of God. St Augustine once said, *God loves each one of us, as if there were only one of us to love.*

It is only through a rejection of God's love that we condemn ourselves.

There is a personal element here. The Son is sent not just to the world in general, but to each of us so that we might be saved through Him.

Think about it: *God so loved me, that God gave His only Son, so that if I believe in Him I will have eternal life.* God loves each and every one of us this way: *my wife, my husband, my child, my parent, my friend, and even my enemy.*

Today's feast of the Trinity invites us to rediscover the many ways in which the love of God is revealed in our lives: in the life God breathes into our souls, in every wonderful work of creation formed by the hand of God, and in the love of God dwelling among us in the love of family and friends.

God is an awesome Lover. Try getting to know Him.

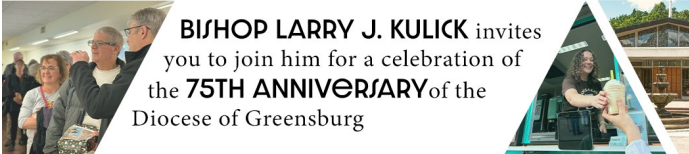


