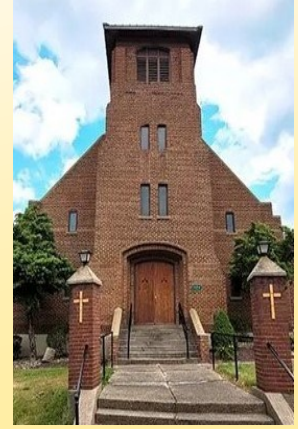

BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

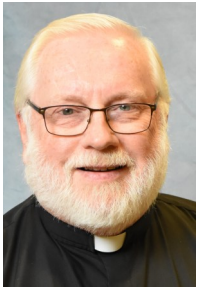
Please Note: Certificates to be a Sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation can only be given to one who is a registered and practicing member of the Parish.

From the Pastor

In the Old Testament, the gift of manna in the desert saved the people of Israel. In the New Testament, Jesus gives us the bread of life - food for our journey to God's promised land.

This Bread of Life is the Body and Blood of Christ, given to make us one with God: *The one who feeds on My flesh and drinks My blood remains in Me, and I in him.* This is the very heart and soul of Catholic teaching and ritual.

When we come into Church, we genuflect to pay respect to the Divine Presence and to remind us that we are before the Lord. We remember His Body was broken and His Blood poured out in love for us. When we are about to receive Communion, we stop and reflect on what it is that we are about to do.

As we eat His Body and drink His Blood, the challenge for us is to do as He did: to become nourishment for others. Just as Jesus gives Himself as food, so too does God ask each one of us to be food for each other - to use our gifts and talents to nourish the lives around us.

The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of the Lord is given to us as a yearly reminder of the Awesome Gift we celebrate that is the Eucharist.

In the Eucharist, bread and wine are transformed by the Spirit of God into the body and blood of Christ. In turn, the sacraments we receive should transform us into sacraments as well -- sacraments of God's love for one another, signs of God's presence to our families and communities.

World Priest Day - June 12, 2026

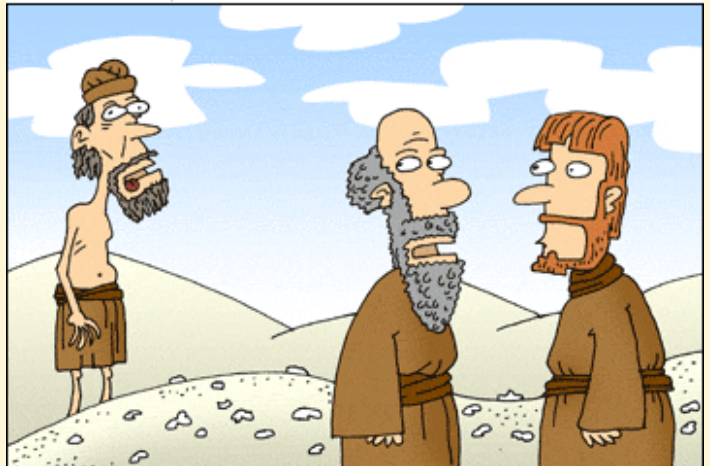
"Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him." (John 6:56)

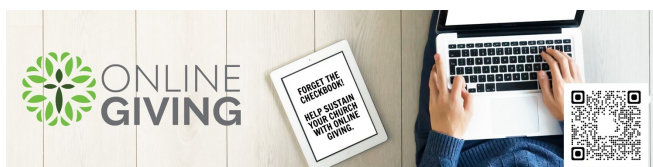

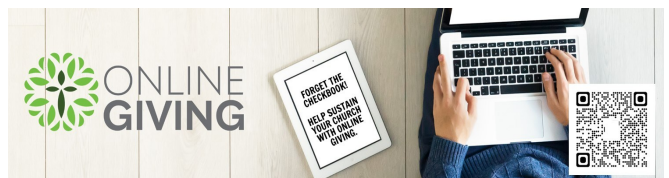


