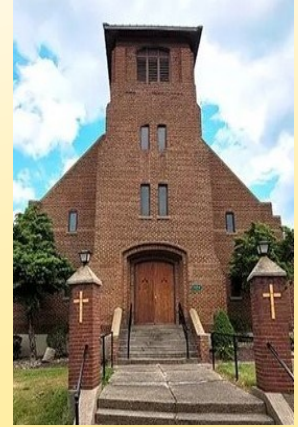

BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

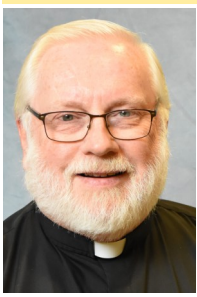
Please Note: Certificates to be a Sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation can only be given to one who is a registered and practicing member of the Parish.

From the Pastor

Have you ever received a really awesome gift? A gift that you did not earn - or even ask for?

Are you grateful for that gift? Would you not want to repay the giver, not out of duty, but out of love for that wonderful gift?

The answer to this question forms the basis for ministry. God gives us awesome blessings as free, heartfelt gifts and in turn, we pass those blessings on to others as gifts.

In today's gospel, Jesus is looking for helpers in His ministry. He chooses very ordinary people with no special education or social advantages. Jesus wants them to serve others freely and to pass on their freely-given gifts.

When the Lord calls you to serve, or you see a need, you must not think you have nothing to offer. Nor feel afraid to share our gifts with others. The Lord calls us to take the gifts we have been given and use them to heal and set others free, and so build up our Father's kingdom.

As Jesus says: *You have received freely, so freely give.* Pass along the grace!

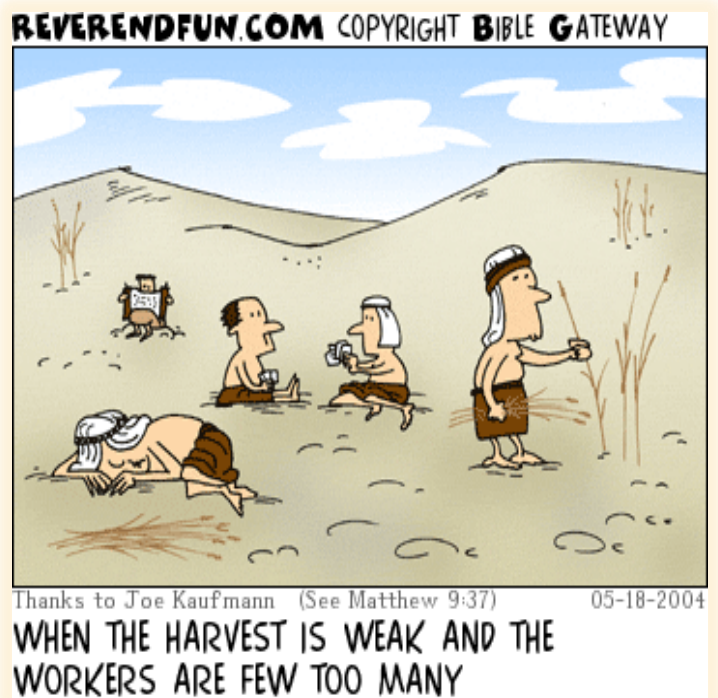
Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time June 14

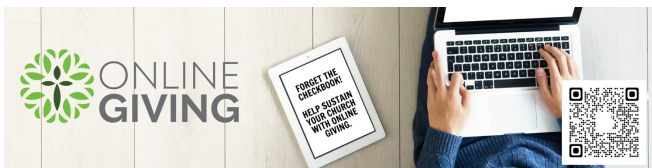

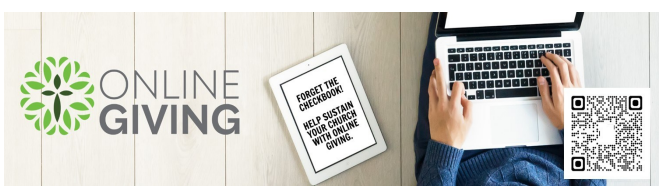


