

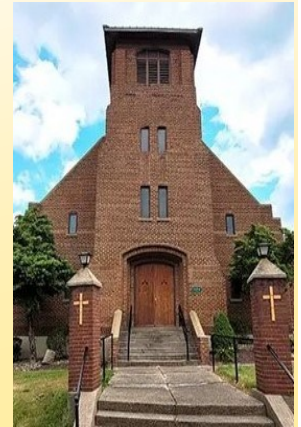

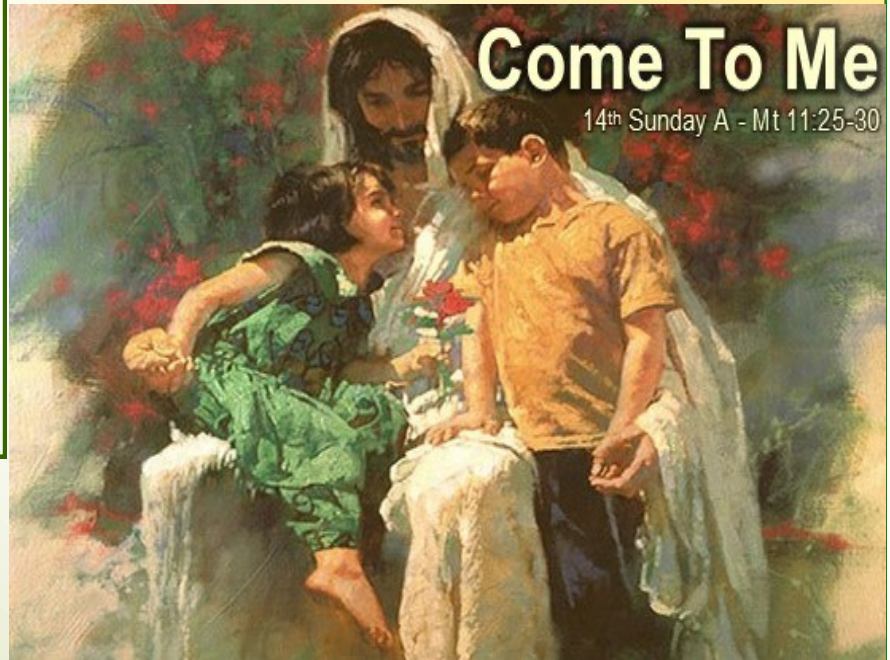

**BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.**

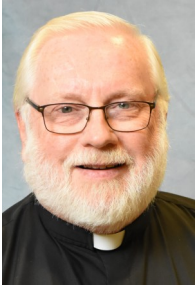
Please Note: Certificates to be a Sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation can only be given to one who is a registered and practicing member of the Parish.

## From the Pastor

In small towns and major cities across the United States this weekend, there are celebrations of liberty and freedom. *Old Glory* will wave, bands will play Sousa marches, and people will gather with ice cream, fried chicken, watermelon, and fireworks.

This Independence Day weekend we are grateful for the many freedoms our pioneers fought for and legislated for us. But our freedom is never perfected until all humanity is truly free.

I have read somewhere that Christians possess 62% of the world's wealth, yet contribute less than 3% of this wealth to charity. Every day, thousands of children die of starvation and preventable diseases. More than one billion people worldwide live in relentless poverty.

As long as there are people dying in wars, as long as there are widows and orphans who are oppressed, as long as there are immigrants unwelcome, and children die of hunger, we are not truly free. As a people and as individuals, we must do all we can to bring independence to all those who seek and cry out for it.

We have been blessed by God through no merit of our own - and our only adequate response to such goodness is gratitude, thanks-giving, understanding that every breath we take is a gift from God, whose love knows neither limit, nor condition.

## 50<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY

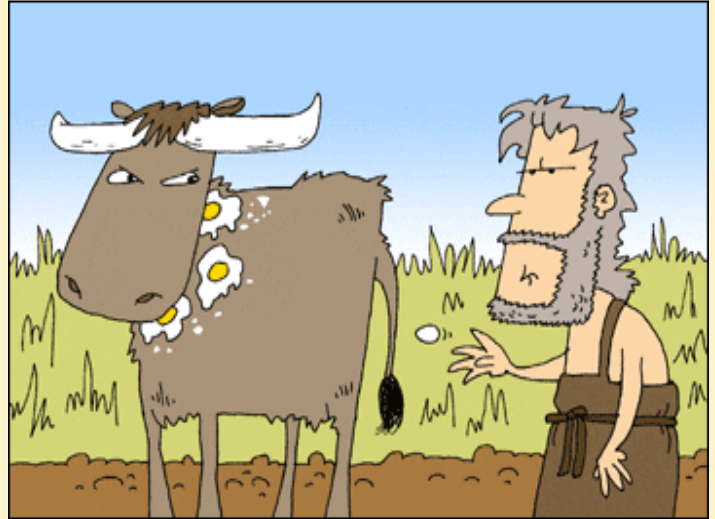
Fifty years ago, I undertook a major commitment to be a Benedictine monk at Saint Vincent Archabbey.

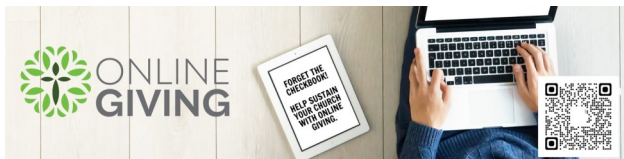

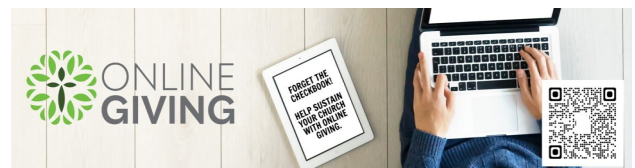

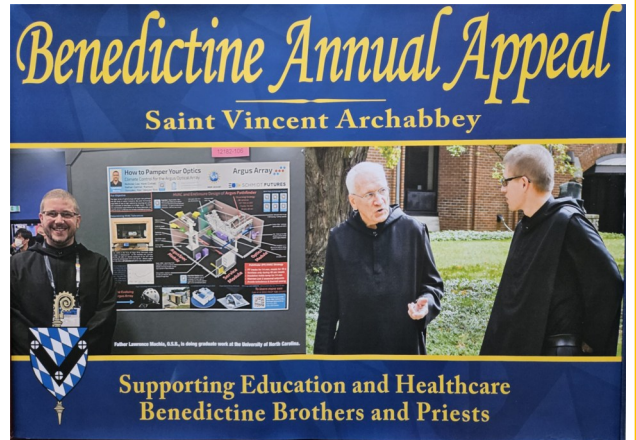
