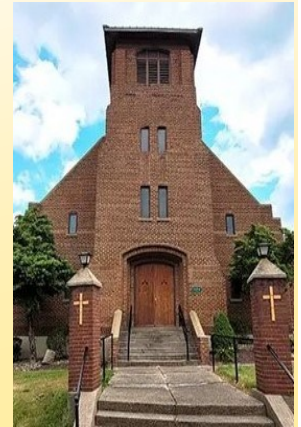

## Consider Remembering Your Parish in Your Will



### From the Pastor

The situation is a familiar one. Even when it is obvious that something needs to be done, there are always many reasons expressed that a project is beyond our resources. *Not enough money, wrong season of the year, too few people*—these are just a few of the excuses.

The disciples were no different. They suggested that since it was late in the day, the people should go and get their own food. They certainly didn't have enough money to feed everyone.

*Give them some food yourselves,* Jesus says.

The miracle Jesus performs in today's Gospel - which the early Church saw as a precursor of the Eucharist - begins with collecting what people are willing to give. Jesus then takes those few pieces of bread and fish and gives them back to the givers.

In the process, Jesus not only increases the food, but in the food, transforms the givers into a community, a community of many different souls who become one in their need, one in the bread they share, one in the love of Christ who has brought them together.

Christ empowers each us to perform our own miracles of creating community when we give of our time and resources to take on the work of the Gospel: to feed the hungry, to care for the sick, to lift up the fallen, to heal the brokenhearted, to seek out the lost and forgotten, to mirror for all the love of God in our midst.

Jesus gave the disciples what they needed to feed the people. He gives us what we need to serve others. When we all share what we do have, miracles can be accomplished!
