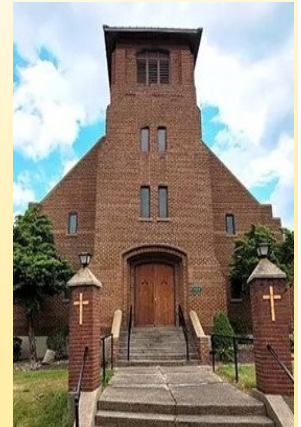

BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

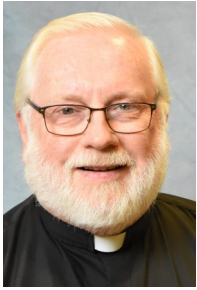

From the Pastor

The disciples were afraid. A small boat on the lake during a storm: afraid not only of the wind and the water, but also of Him. When they saw Jesus walking on the water, they cried out: *It is a ghost!*

Fear cripples us. Peter felt the fear, but when Jesus tells them that it is He, Peter asks Jesus: *Command me to come to you on the water.* Even though Peter failed to make it to Jesus, the story of Peter's water-walking adventure was a success when compared to the behavior of the other disciples. They never even tried to get out of the boat at all!

Far too many of us are reluctant to step out of our comfort zones. Afraid to fail, get hurt, or look stupid. But, as Peter learned, we walk by faith. As long as Peter kept his eyes on Jesus, he walked successfully on the water! It was when he took his eyes off of Jesus, that he began to sink.

Life is hard sometimes. Storms do come our way. Wind and waves will rock our boat. We cannot allow fear to bind us. We need to walk on the waters of faith. When we focus on our fears, or when we try to go it alone, we will surely sink! Instead, we need to keep our eyes fixed upon Jesus. If we step out in faith looking to Him, in the midst of our storms, He will give us an inner calm in the outer chaos.

But, if you want to walk on water, you've got to get out of the boat!

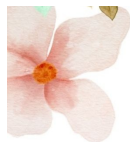
