From the Pastor

A pagan Canaanite woman came to Jesus with her need. Her child needed help! And she believed Jesus could help her.

She was passionate. She was persistent. She cried out to Him even though everything and everyone seemed to be against her -- race, religious background, gender, the disciples, Satan, and seemingly even Jesus! She seized the initiative and broke down every barrier. She was unstoppable! She stayed focused on her objective until the promise was given.

Jesus was impressed. *O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish,* he says.

Compare this to the words we heard addressed to the apostle Peter in last week's Gospel: *O you of little faith, why did you doubt?* Peter was a Jew, Jesus' friend, and one of the chosen twelve; yet this Canaanite woman had shown greater faith than Peter and her faith is rewarded.

The result? Jesus commended her for her faith and healed her daughter.

You might wonder, who are the Canaanites among us today? Who might WE want to see Jesus send away? Who do WE not welcome into our fellowship? When was the last time you reached out to others different from you? When did you serve the poor, the sick, or the needy?

We too are invited to approach Jesus with bold persistence. God made us all in His image. We all possess the power to choose. When we see the face of God in the stranger, and choose to serve others, especially those different from ourselves, we choose to be like Jesus and act with God's own compassion.

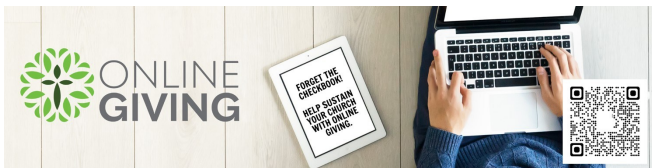

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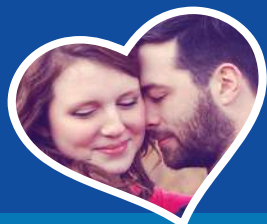
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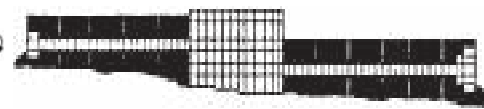
