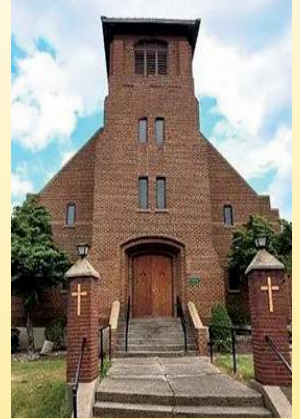

From the Pastor

Farmers in Japan, are growing watermelons for shipment — only these are no ordinary melons, they're square! They were placed in tempered-glass cubes while still growing. Why would anyone want a square watermelon? They're much easier to store in a refrigerator!

It's amusing to think of how a naturally round watermelon can become square because of the shape of the container in which it's grown. But it reminds us of the forces in the world that exert their influence on us and attempt to shape us. That's why Saint Paul tells us not to be *conformed to this age*, but to *Be transformed by the renewal of your mind*.

So, too, when Jesus speaks of his coming passion, death and resurrection, Simon stands opposed. Jesus asks him to *Get behind me!* To follow Jesus is to take up represents a value system that runs counter to our world. The world teaches us to think only of ourselves, but Jesus sacrificed himself on the cross because he loves us. In sacrifice, we learn to love. Through sacrifice, we learn how much we are loved. Jesus Christ is inviting us to liberate ourselves -- from ourselves -- so that we might be completely free to love selflessly, as He did.

The pressures of our world will continue to try to shape us, but they will not succeed if we strive to be true disciples of Jesus and live his example of generous, selfless service to others.

Offer yourselves as a living sacrifice to God, and allow His love to change us from within.

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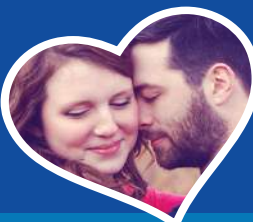
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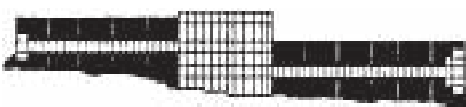
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
