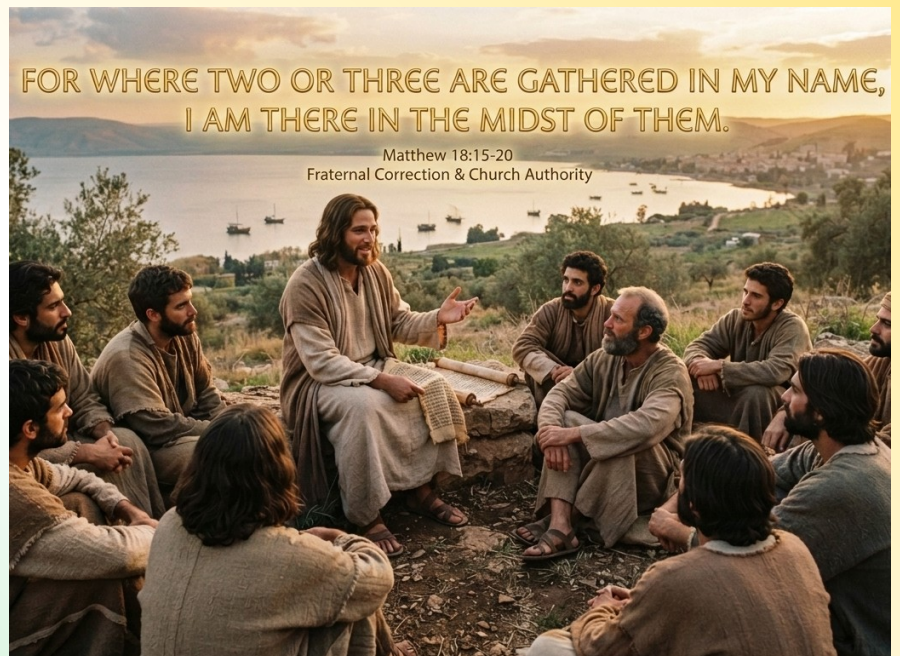

BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

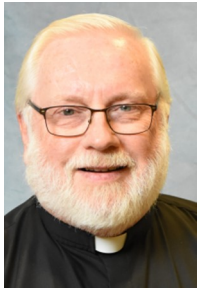
Note: Certificates to be a Sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation can only be given to one who is a registered and practicing member of the Parish.

From the Pastor

What should we do with someone in our midst whose behavior is destructive?

We tend to play games: Hints are dropped. Conversation is abbreviated. Affection is withheld, and the air gets chilly.

Grudges or resentments more often die with those who hold them, than come to resolution in quiet conversation. Some families will go years before addressing a problem.

Jesus challenges us not to tolerate dysfunction in our lives, but to confront the problems, issues and misunderstandings and that divide and embitter us. He tells us first to go directly to the person, tell them how you feel. Listen with respect to each other and try to work things out. But, if the person won't listen, gather a few mutual friends -- not to gang up on the person, but to surround this person with love. The idea is to respect persons, not to demean them. Finally, for something big, and truly important, Jesus calls for the whole church to try to reach out to this person.

Jesus calls us to the hard work of reconciliation: to be committed to seeking solutions to problems, not out of anger, nor a sense of injustice for what we have suffered, but out of a commitment to imitate the great love and mercy of God.

He assures us that whenever we gather in His name, He is here in our midst. Be aware Jesus is here with us. Be aware He calls us to the hard struggle of building communities which welcome back the lost and alienated. And be aware He is with us always, not to judge us, but to love us. .
