BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

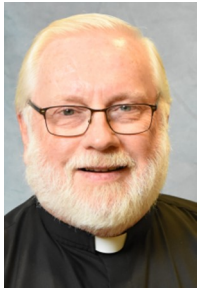
Note: Certificates to be a Sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation can only be given to one who is a registered and practicing member of the Parish.

Consider Remembering Your Parish in Your Will



From the Pastor

Life is a lot like bumper cars at an amusement park. You get in your car, and when you get hit, you chase the one who has hit you, and hope to bump that person *harder* than they have bumped you.

That may be a fun strategy for bumper cars, but it's a terrible strategy for life. When you get bumped in life, bumping back only escalates matters, until everyone suffers damage.

Far too many of us cling to past hurts, or offended pride. We take a hit, then look to hit others back and keep hitting, until utterly exhausted.

Jesus had a better strategy: *Forgive!*

In today's gospel, the king says, *I forgave you. .. because you begged me. Should you not also have had compassion on your fellow servant, just as I had pity on you?* Jesus is telling us that we forgive, not because they deserve it, but because we've been forgiven! How often has God forgiven us, over and over again? Forgive, as the Lord has forgiven us!

Jesus even gave his life for us, while we were still in sin. Look at all that we have received from the Lord! Whatever pain we may receive from others is minor compared to the gifts God has given us, and eternal life to come! Don't let pain destroy your ability to receive God's gifts.

Pay what you owe is the lifestyle of misery. Forgiveness really is the only way to live happily.

Daily we pray: *Forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.*

Since we are among those who've been forgiven much, let's stop the damage and share that blessing with others.

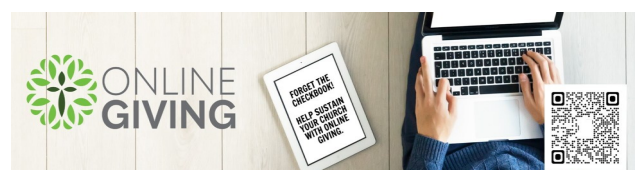

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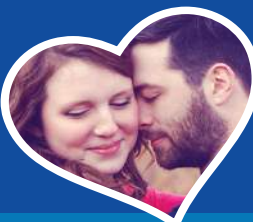
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
