BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

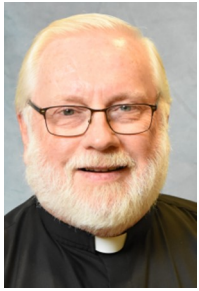
Note: Certificates to be a Sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation can only be given to one who is a registered and practicing member of the Parish.

From the Pastor

Everyone likes receiving a gift. There is something wonderful and unexpected about a gift. A gift is never earned in the way that a wage is earned. It is pure love, wonderful and undeserved.

In today's gospel, Jesus tells a story of a man who wants to share his wealth with anyone he can find. He goes out again and again and again looking for more people to bring into his vineyard, not because of what he is going to get out of them, but because he has so much to give them. He goes on to give everyone just what they need - a full day's wage - whether they earned it or not. No one is going away empty-handed or slighted.

Jesus likes to talk about a God who does things like that: who gives gifts. He tells us God is extravagantly generous, generous to a fault. Jesus himself is the best example of our lavishly generous God: He willingly gives up His life for us on a cross -- the ultimate revelation of God's extravagant love.

Too bad the workers in today's Gospel are filled with the fire of envy. They are so obsessed with what others have been given, that they fail to realize all that they themselves have received. They see the generosity of the landowner, but feel cheated.

Like the workers in this story, we can grumble and resent the good things given to others. We can fail to appreciate all the good God has given to us. Or we can share the same generous Spirit of Jesus.

The choice is ours.
