From the Pastor

One son says: Yes, that he'll go immediately and serve his father zealously. But he never did go. Selfishly, he disregarded his father and never did work in the father's vineyard.

Talk is cheap. It's what we *do*, that shows what our intentions really are. It is not enough to say that we will do something; we must actually do it. The Hebrew people said they would obey their God, but they were faithless again and again. But are we Christians any better? It is not enough to say we are Christians, but then only go through the motions, not living it. *O yes, God, I will be your faithful disciple. Yep, count on me!* But they don't do a darn thing.

The other son says: *No!* He rebels, showing disrespect to his father. He wishes to go his own way in life, and rebels at being told what to do. He would have his own way; do his own thing! However, this son later repents and does exactly what his father asks him to do: he went to work.

Some who grow up Christian, may initially say yes to the Lord, only to turn away later. Yet, any of us may also have made terrible mistakes in the course of our years. Like the one son, we may have said 'no' to God. But, then we begin to see things differently. We repent, and our 'no' becomes a 'yes'.

Jesus asks us, who does the will of the father? The answer was and still is so obvious: It is the one who actually goes and does what God wants done; it's going to work in the Father's vineyard.

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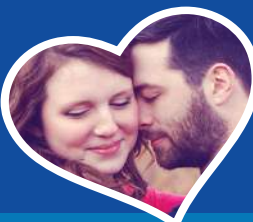
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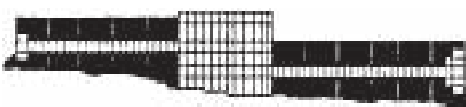
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
